Tour Summary

After meeting up in Bangkok, the capital of Thailand, we enjoyed a welcome dinner together at our comfortable hotel. Over dinner, we discussed the plans for the coming days of our exciting adventure! The following morning we awoke, excited at the prospect of going in search of one of the most sought-after waders in the world: you guessed it, the unique Spoon-billed Sandpiper! After an early breakfast, we set off across the sprawling capital – *the growth of which over the last few years was clearly evident*. After arriving at Pak Thale Saltworks in good time, we set about searching for the great diversity of waders and waterbirds this area has to offer.

Amongst a splendid array of species, notable sightings included good numbers of Indian Cormorant, a large flock of Pied Avocet, Pacific Golden Plover, Lesser and Greater Sand Plovers, one Far Eastern Curlew seen amongst a huge flock of Eurasian Curlew, dozens of Broad-billed Sandpiper, a single Temminck's Stint, two Long-toed Stint, a nice flock of Asian Dowitcher, four Red-necked Phalarope, Spotted Redshank, a single Nordmann's Greenshank, Slender-billed Gull, Germain's Swiftlet and

Golden-bellied Gerygone. Early on during our search, the shout went up as Uthai located a superb Spoon-billed Sandpiper which put on a great show. We were all able to enjoy extended scope views of this highly sought-after species. It was then time for lunch, and we enjoyed the wonderful Thai cuisine which was a regular highlight throughout the tour. In the afternoon, we took a boat trip to Laem Phak Bia and enjoyed superb sightings of Pacific Reef Heron, a splendid Chinese Egret in breeding plumage, our key target here, Malaysian Plover and lovely Black-capped Kingfisher. Thereafter, we drove to Kaeng Krachan National Park for a wonderful three-night stay.

Kaeng Krachan is one of my favourite parks in Thailand, due to the fact that it covers a large area of pristine habitat – covering both mid and low elevation forest, is less touristy, has the highest diversity

of birds in Thailand with over 420 species recorded, and also offers good mammals. During our two full days in the park, we explored both upper and lower elevations as well as some interior forest trails. Highlights were many, some of our star sightings included fabulous Kalij Pheasant feeding leisurely along the road, Jerdon's Baza, Crested Goshawk displaying, Common Emerald Dove, Thick-billed Green Pigeon, Mountain Imperial Pigeon on its nest, Raffles's Malkoha, Banded Bay, Square-tailed Drongo- and Large Hawk-Cuckoos, Collared and Asian Barred Owlets, Large-tailed Nightjar, Pacific Swift, Banded Kingfisher, Blue-bearded and Chestnut-headed Bee-eaters, elusive Tickell's Brown Hornbill, Great, Green-eared and Blue-eared Barbets, tiny White-browed Piculet, Greater Yellow-nape, beautiful Heart-spotted and Bay Woodpeckers, Common Flameback, a pair of Black-thighed Falconet, Vernal Hanging Parrot, stunning Banded and Black-and-yellow Broadbills, White-bellied Erpornis, Blyth's Shrike-Babbler, handsome Sultan Tit, Yellow-bellied Warbler, Everett's White-eye, Eyebrowed Thrush, and Rufous-browed, Hill, Blue-throated and Chinese Blue Flycatchers.

The following morning, we enjoyed some superb birding around our lodge grounds. Here we added a splendid Yellow Bittern, a pair of Indian Stone-curlew, cute Spotted Owllet, Eurasian Hoopoe raising his crest, Lineated Barbet, Rufous Treepie, and skulking Black-browed Reed and a super confiding Lanceolated Warbler – *what a treat!* Tearing ourselves away from this wonderful place, we headed off to some more wetlands around Ban Ta Boon. Here we found good numbers of waterfowl, including Lesser Whistling Duck, Gadwall, Eurasian Wigeon, Northern Pintail and rare vagrant Red-crested Pochard. Other sightings here included superb Painted Stork in breeding plumage, Black-headed Ibis,

Purple Heron, a lone Spot-billed Pelican, Black-winged Kite, Greater Spotted Eagle, Eastern Marsh and Pied Harriers, Ashy Woodswallow and Grey-breasted Prinia. From here, we travelled to the Sakaerat Research Station, where we enjoyed some splendid late afternoon birding. Both Red Junglefowl and Siamese Fireback gave us wonderful views and everyone enjoyed taking some photos of these stunning pheasants.

The next day, we birded the lowland *Dipterocarp* woodland of Sab Sadao and then enjoyed some wetlands in the afternoon. Sab Sadao was rewarding; and whilst exploring the network of tracks, we

notched up the following sightings: Rufous-winged Buzzard, glimpses of Yellow-legged Buttonquail, Grey-capped Pygmy Woodpecker, Freckle-breasted Woodpecker at our accommodation, stunning Black-headed Woodpecker, Red-breasted Parakeet, Large Cuckooshrike, Rosy and Small Minivets, Eurasian Jay, Indochinese Bush Lark, Red-rumped Swallow and Common Hill Myna.

After lunch, we travelled to some wetlands en route to Khao Yai. Our first stop yielded the lovely Cotton Pygmy Goose, Grey-headed Swamphen, Pheasant-tailed and Bronze-winged Jacanas and a pair of bathing Black-collared Starling. At the following lake, we were surprised to find a number of sought-after species, which included several Greater Painted-snipe, a superb Pin-tailed Snipe, Plaintive Cuckoo, quite a few Oriental Skylark, Plain-backed Sparrow, Eastern Yellow Wagtail, Richard's and Red-throated Pipits and a fabulous 15 Rain Quail. Delighted, we travelled to our accommodation near Khao Yai for a splendid three nights.

Khao Yai is another fabulous National Park; and although very touristy, it did not hinder our birding. We were treated to stunning views of Coral-billed Ground Cuckoo, Blue Pitta, Siberian Blue Robin and Orange-headed Thrush coming to feed along a channel at the main camping site in the park – *what a start!* Shortly afterwards, we enjoyed great scope views of the impressive White-handed Gibbon. We explored a number of roads and trails during our stay, giving us access to both interior forest birds as well as edge species. More highlights included good views of the secretive Green-legged Partridge, Brown Hawk-Owl, Great Eared Nightjar, a splendid male Red-headed Trogon, Great and Wreathed Hornbills, a family group of Great Slaty Woodpecker, Long-tailed Broadbill, highly elusive Eared Pitta, Great Iora, Swinhoe's Minivet, Greater Racket-tailed Drongo, Radde's Warbler, Large Scimitar

Babbler, White-crested and Lesser Necklaced Laughingthrushes, Asian Fairy-bluebird, Puff-throated Babbler, White-rumped Shama, Hainan Blue Flycatcher, Golden-fronted Leafbird, Thick-billed and Yellow-vented Flowerpeckers, Crimson and Van Hasselt's Sunbirds and smart Pin-tailed Parrotfinch. We also enjoyed a number of sightings of Asian Elephant and two confiding Malayan Porcupine.

The following morning, at a local temple, we found the desired Limestone Wren-Babbler and then travelled back to Bangkok. A visit to Rangsit Marsh was rewarding, as we found White-browed Crake, Pink-necked Green Pigeon, Blue-

tailed Bee-eater, Malaysian Pied Fantail, Yellow-bellied Prinia and Java Sparrow nearby. It was then time for our flight to Chiang Mai. The short flight was on time and we overnighted at a comfortable hotel in Chiang Mai. After dinner, some participants enjoyed a visit to the night market for some shopping.

The next morning, we departed early for a visit to the King's project and enjoyed good views of Green Peafowl, which was scoped displaying – *an impressive bird indeed!* We also added yet another of the stunning blue flycatchers to our ever growing list, Tickell's Blue Flycatcher. From here, we travelled to Doi Inthanon for a splendid three-night stay.

Our time in the park was spent exploring the various habitats, from the moss-laden branches of the montane forest near the peak to the mid-elevation forest where we enjoyed numerous mixed species flocks, and lowland broad-leafed *Dipterocarp* forest. We enjoyed many highlights during

our stay, and some of the more noteworthy sightings include a close soaring Eastern Buzzard, Speckled and Ashy Wood Pigeons, lovely Asian Emerald Cuckoo, super confiding Oriental Scops Owl, Brown Wood Owl during the day, Golden-throated Barbet, Stripe-breasted Woodpecker, a pair of the smart Collared Falconet, a family of Silver-breasted Broadbill, Grey-chinned, Short-billed, Scarlet and Long-tailed Minivets, Black-eared and Clicking Shrike-Babblers, Lesser Racket-tailed Drongo, Yellow-bellied Fantail, Yellow-cheeked Tit, Striated and rare White-headed Bulbuls, delightful Pygmy Wren-Babbler, confiding Slaty-bellied Tesia, Rufous-winged Fulvetta, splendid Eye-browed Wren-Babbler, Silver-eared Laughingthrush, Bar-throated Minla, Grey-headed Parrotbill, Hume's Treecreeper, sought-after Dark-sided Thrush, magical Green Cochoa, Large, Small and rare Vivid Niltavas, White-browed Shortwing, Black-backed Forktail, rare Yellow-bellied Flowerpecker and Green-tailed Sunbird.

Leaving Doi Inthanon, we visited a local birder's garden, where his canopy tower gave us great views of the surrounding woodland. Here we notched up great views of Blossom-headed Parakeet, Black-hooded Oriole, Red-billed Blue Magpie and Striated Swallow. Nearby, some folk were lucky to see Chinese Francolin and Ruddy-breasted Crake.

Continuing north, we stopped off at some rice paddies where we notched up Grey-headed Lapwing and then at Mae Taeng

irrigation project, we found Pallas's Grasshopper Warbler, Little Ringed Plover, Green Sandpiper, Wire-tailed Swallow, Red Avadavat and Citrine Wagtail. In the late afternoon, we spent time at Chiang Dao, where we enjoyed good views of Pin-tailed Green Pigeon and Black-throated Laughingthrush. Leaving there, we made our way to Doi Lang for a fabulous three-night stay.

We enjoyed a wonderful two days birding at this fabulous site. Some of our best birding of the tour took place at Doi Lang. We were fortunate to be able to access both sides of the mountain road, giving us chances for a number of rare birds. Highlights included stunning views of tricky species such as Mountain Bamboo Partridge and Mrs Hume's Pheasant – *both of which were seen on several occasions*. Others included Grey-faced Buzzard, Oriental Turtle Dove, Himalayan Swiftlet, hundreds of Cook's Swift, a superb pair of Crimson-breasted Woodpecker, Lesser Yellow-nape, Grey-backed Shrike, Slender-billed Oriole, Japanese and tiny Fire-capped Tits (seldom seen in Thailand), Crested Finchbill, Black-throated Bushtit, Hill Prinia, Collared Babbler, White-necked and White-browed Laughingthrushes, spectacular Scarlet-faced Liocichla, Rufous-backed and Long-tailed Sibilias, amazing Spot-breasted and Pale-billed Parrotbills, Whiskered Yuhina, Chestnut-vented and much sought-after Giant Nuthatches, Chestnut Thrush, Pale Blue Flycatcher, Rufous-bellied Niltava, White-bellied Redstart, cracking Siberian Rubythroat, White-tailed Robin, Red-flanked and Himalayan Bluetails, Rufous-gorgeted, awesome Ultramarine and Slaty-blue Flycatchers, Blue and Chestnut-bellied Rock Thrushes, Spot-winged Grosbeak and Crested Bunting. An afternoon's birding at Tha Ton produced Small Pratincole, secretive Baikal Bush Warbler and Chestnut-capped and Yellow-eyed Babblers.

Our final site of the tour was Doi Angkhang, where we enjoyed some superb birding near the Burmese border. After repeated attempts, we finally got to see the very elusive Mountain Scops Owl, a spectacular Hodgson's Frogmouth performed extremely well, lovely Burmese Shrike, Maroon Oriole, Brown-breasted Bulbul, Yellow-streaked Warbler, Streaked Wren-Babbler, Striated Yuhina, Japanese White-eye, beautiful Scaly and Black-breasted Thrushes and Olive-backed Pipit.

It was then time to head back to Chiang Mai to connect with our flight back to Bangkok in order to catch our International

departure flights home. And so ended another wonderful adventure! Thanks must go to a wonderful group of enthusiastic and fun participants, as well as a superb ground operations team. I am very much looking forward to travelling with you all again!
